Budweiser Corporate Racing League

Rules and Information

Each team will submit their roster prior to the start of the program using a Budweiser Corporate Racing League Roster form. The Corporate Team registration fee is \$175.00.

The program will run each Thursday night for eight weeks starting the first Thursday in January. The first night is a non-scored practice night, the next six nights will be scored, and the final night will be Racing Party Night.

The race course will be open from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. Skiers/Riders can take their runs any time during these hours once they have obtained their race ticket at the ticket counter. The race fee is \$12.00 per race, which provides a race ticket good for two runs, entry in the prize drawing, and access to the buffet. (Please note that this race fee is for this specific event; it covers the costs involved in setting, running, and timing the race as well as the buffet provided.) Participants who hold season passes should know that this is a completely separate event and that the race fee is applied specifically to this event. A season pass does not cover this race event! Let it be known that one of the most enjoyable parts of the evening is the social gathering that takes place after 8:00 in the Brookside Lounge, sponsored by Budweiser. Your ticket will qualify you to win a slew of prizes, and Lost Valley will offer special prices on Budweiser beer and other drinks, and an open buffet.

- Each team roster will consist of at least 5 racers, with a maximum of 12. Budweiser provides just 12 winning jackets per season.
- All team members must be at least 21 years of age.
- Each team will be allowed only 2 substitutions in a season.
- Changing one's sex or equipment during the season will be deemed a substitution.
- Each team must have a snowboard racer, telemark racer, or a female racer.

- Each racer will take 2 timed runs. If one of the runs is not taken or is not finished, that racer will be given a DNF (Did Not Finish).
- Handicaps will be computed as follows:
 - 1 second off total time for each decade of age starting at 30.
 - 10% for women
 - 15% for snowboarders
 - 10 % for telemark skiers

Lost Valley will determine if a race night is to be cancelled due to inclement weather or inadequate course conditions. Lost Valley will call each team captain for notification of a cancellation by 1:00 PM on that race day. It is the responsibility of the team captains to notify their team members. Lost Valley will make every effort to make up that week. It is not our desire to cancel race night, so if at all possible, we will refrain from cancellation.

Refunds: Lost Valley will make every effort to reschedule a cancelled race night. This will, of course, depend on the length of the season and snow conditions. There are no refunds.

Only the top 4 racers on each team will count for the total team score, with the requirement that one "alternative" racer's time (female racer, snowboarder, or telemark racer) be included in that 4.

The team with the most points wins. The winner will be announced and the grand prizes awarded on the final Racing Party Night.

The results for each week will be unofficial until the end of a jury period in effect until the finish of the event on the following week. Any protests concerning a race or results will have to be received by the end of the next week's race at 8:00 PM. The last scored week's jury period will end 1 hour after the official post time of that week's results.

Each week's results will be posted and the weekly prizes drawn during the post-race party in the Brookside Lounge.
